***** Tomatoes will be in 3.5 x5" pots and cost \$3.50 each.**

Tomato:

1. **Evan's Xtra Early** (57 days) well flavoured, firm, red mid-sized, clusters, (developed in Alberta)
2. **Big Beef** (70 days) Staking type, vigorous, productive and disease-resistant plants with tasty, large fruits
3. **Red Robin** (55 days) 1 ¼ inch extra sweet red cherry tomatoes - suitable for pots. Determinate
4. **Celebrity** (70 days) very plump, robust tomatoes. Fruits weigh approximately 8 oz., and are 4 inches across. Plants need caging or staking, and produce fruit throughout the growing season. **SOLD OUT**
5. **Costoluto** – a large, juicy Italian heirloom tomato with an acidic-tart full-tomato flavor well suited for slicing and serving fresh or cooking.
6. **Amana Orange** – huge, light **orange**, fluted beefsteak **tomatoes**. They can get up to 2 lbs each, and have a sweet, almost tropical fruit flavor. Indeterminate.
7. **Heinz** - very high yields of uniform bright red 3in fruits which are perfect in salads or for sauces. A robust variety delivering heavy leafed plants with good disease and crack resistance.
8. **Cherokee Purple**- An old **Cherokee** Indian heirloom, pre-1890 variety; beautiful, deep, dusky **purple**-pink color, superb sweet flavor, and very-large-sized fruit.
These **tomatoes** are delicious and grow big, healthy plants!
9. **Chocolate Sprinkles** –very sweet, sweetest and earliest. Indeterminate. High yields of 5-7 fruit clusters, 50-55 days, crack resistant.
10. **Golden Cherry** - best, sweetest tasting. Indeterminate, very thin skin, resistant to cracking, 60 – 65 days. Very robust grower.

11. **Black Krim Tomato** – Very desirable heritage tomato. Similar in colour to Cherokee Purple. Smokey flavour. 5 star rating. Large fruit.
12. **Chadwick Cherry Tomato** – clusters of 1” cherry tomatoes. Very sweet. Prolific. Indeterminate.

***** Peppers will be in 3.5” x 5” pots and cost \$3.50 each.**

Pepper:

1. **Sweet Pepper Hyb. Early Prolific (55 days)**. Fertilize weekly with 1-52-17 Don't plant out until June. Green.
2. **Sweet Sunset Pepper**
..a compact banana **pepper** that is vigorous and sets a large amount of concentrated fruit. High yielding, attractive colorful tasty **peppers** that are great fresh or canned. The compact upright plants can be grown in a container. Turns yellow when time to eat.

***** Cucumbers and cabbages will be in packs of 4 and cost \$3.00 each.**

Cucumber:

1. **National Pickling** – (55 days) Fertilize with 10-52-17 for first three weeks. Dill size at 2in.; slicers when full grown.
2. **Eureka Cucumbers**
All purpose **cucumber!** **Eureka** is an all purpose hybrid variety. Strong, vigorous monoecious plants produce an abundance of fruit. The flavourful, crisp fruit is harvested at 2-5” for pickles and 3-7” for the fresh market. Excellent disease resistance.

Cabbage

1. **Golden Acre Cabbages** – 64 days. Very early, high quality sort. Dense, solid heads are very spherical, 5-7 inches in diameter and weigh 3-5 pounds. Heritage variety.

***** Gourds, pumpkins, zucchini and both types of squash**

will be in 3.5" x 3.5" pots and cost \$3.00 each.

Gourds:

1. **Gremlin Gourds** are bright, bold, and crazy with warts. (5–7"+) **gourds** with various solid and speckled vibrant colors, in a multitude of shapes: stars, wings, acorns, mushrooms, necks, and more.

Pumpkin 'Naked Bear' – Small pumpkins – great for pies, and seeds have no hulls, great roasted.

Zucchini 'Golden Glory'- (50 days) **Frost Tender so do not plant out until after last frost in May.**

Acorn Squash - 'Table King' _85 days

Winter Squash 'Burgess Buttercup' (100 days)

Heritage Black Squash (forgot the name)...flat round shape.... very desirable eating quality
